It has been a while since we wrote ...life got little too busy for us...

We are very thankful for your prayers and the financial support we've been receiving. Thanks for praying for the sale of our house. It happened, we sold it. We are out of the house! It was definitely God's timing not ours. We could of never picked more trustworthy people to sell it too! We did not have to worry about the money or the paper work. It was totally God! So we thank you for praying for it. God answers prayers when we wait for HIS timing!

Most of our lives we have been working on the guest house. Now we are living there out of boxes too. It should be ready soon. It was quite a thing for us to finally be packing and moving, quite emotional...

Please pray for our churches here. We are facing a lot of challenges as we are losing more and more leaders to America and we have no one to step in to do ministry. We sent off our second family to the US this year and one of the pastors who helped me with three villages, died few weeks ago. Please pray for the workers.

The rest of our lives are just usual; 4 services for me a week, bible studies, we had tent evangelism and then one week of a crusade, three of those days Franklin Graham was speaking (by satellite). Many people came forward, over 100, but we will see how many of them are going to stay. Now I am trying to meet with new believers as well to help them in their walk with God. There were also 6 funerals for me. Three of those families were non-Christian people. It was a great opportunity to share with them about God and the love, peace and hope that we can have in Him.

It was wonderful to see people committing themselves to God through baptism. 12 people were baptized this summer. We also experienced a loss of our loved Grandma Anna in July (Nadya's grandma). We are still missing her and are grieving but know with confidence that one day we are going to see her again. Praise God for that Promise!

Nadya is very busy with the guest house, helping one of the workers. She can't wait for it to be finished though. Then home visitations, buying drugs for ill people, paying widows bills and the list goes on and on. She gets tired but is very thankful that there are funds being provided by people like you, to be able to do so. She also is getting ready to organize camps that are coming up in few days. It is not going to be too easy this year to chose who comes and who does not, as there are not as many funds as last year for it.

More than anything we ask you to pray for us , for wisdom and strength to live each day in God's will, to find time to be with God... sometimes it seems very difficult to do so in all the business of our lives. May God be with all of you,
