Residence Building Project

The residence building has been the focal point of activity for Haiti ARISE Ministries (HAM) since 2003. The second floor addition has recently been completed and now serves as living quarters for teams and long-term volunteers. It will allow for medical clinics to be facilitated on the bottom floor without disrupting teams' living spaces. The addition is entirely furnished, and includes two sets of finished bathrooms, four bedrooms and a classroom, as well as other improvements to the overall building. The project was completed by employing people from the community, and students of HAM were involved with the fabrication and furnishing aspects of the project. HFL has already facilitated one team from Cranbrook, BC that enjoyed the use of the new facilities, with the bedroom air conditioners being a major hit!

✓ Results

- › Furnishings were provided for every room (desks, beds, dressers, etc.)
- › 2 bathrooms were completed, complete with fixtures and tiled showers
- › 10 fans were installed in bedrooms and common areas
- › 4 air conditioners were installed in bedrooms
- › Inverter and battery system were designed and installed as back up power source
- › 42 sliding windows with screens were installed
- › 19 wooden doors hung
- › Steel railings were installed on balconies and stairs
