Water Well Construction

To have the most impact possible for dollars/time spent in all areas of life, clean water wells are by far the greatest investment in community transformation. Children in the Grand Goave community would otherwise need to haul clean water from an alternate source; some children walked 4 km to get access to water.

A new well was drilled on the high point of a hill on a two-acre parcel of land designated for a goat farm to allow for gravity irrigation of crops and water system.



✓ Results

- › Hit very good clean water at 135 feet deep.
- › A goat farm is to be used as part of a trade school and also to bless the community with goats, milk and cheese.
- › A larger water well than normal was drilled to be used as a hand pump as well as an electric pump (a typical well would only allow one pump system).
- › Provided an electric pump for the goat farm facility and future water tower.
- › Provided a hand pump for the goat farm but also for the community to access clean water which has immediate effects.
- › On average over 1000 lives are changed by one clean water well.
