

Present Realities:

Jacmel is a city of 34,000 people located about 40 km SW of Port-au-Prince, founded over 300 years ago. Located in a small bay along the Caribbean it is a beautiful city with a rich heritage, many of the houses and business date back to the early 19th century.

The earthquake on January 12th has set this city back many years: 1,785 homes were completely destroyed, 54 schools destroyed, 26 churches were demolished, close to 3,000 people are dead and over 6,000 families displaced from their homes.

Hungry For Life is working alongside a local partner called Joy In Hope. Their goal is to change Haiti from the inside-out by spiritually influencing Haitians, creating a generation who know and love the Lord and will help positively affect the future of their communities. It is the vision of Joy In Hope to develop their property in Raymond, a community near Jacmel, and create a resource for the entire community including 8 homes, that will house up to 160 orphaned and abandoned children, a school for up to 800 children, a church, a community center, medical clinic and a recreation area.

Plan of Action:

Joy In Hope (JIH) has become a large part of the earthquake relief activities that have commenced in the days following January 12th, being involved in food distributions, medical clinics and home reconstruction. Their efforts during the earthquake have cemented their involvement in the city of Jacmel and their vision to change Haiti one family at a time. The immediate need in their long term vision is to begin construction on two of their orphan care homes which will house 40 kids for the next 15+ years on their project site in Raymond, Haiti. Other opportunities for community transformation include:
