

# House Building – Tijuana, Baja California, Mexico



## Purpose:

The object is to construct homes for needy families in the city of Tijuana, Mexico, and to assist the Mexican church to show families the love of God.

## Present Realities:

The Tijuana area is home for over two million people many of whom are very poor and lack weatherproof housing, sufficient food, and medical care. Many people from other parts of Mexico have migrated to the area in hope of finding employment in the factories that were established since the signing of the North American Free Trade Agreement.

## Plan of Action:

The plan is to construct homes for needy families chosen by Baja Vision Ministries. The size of the home is determined by the number of family members. Most of the building materials are purchased locally. We will also provide food and other essential items to individual families, local children's homes, a women's shelter and a seniors' home, all operated by Baja Vision Ministries. It is also our desire to support the work of a local Christian doctor who provides free medical care to these families and individuals.



## Positive Benefits:

Raise the standard of living by increasing the physical and spiritual health of the people of the Tijuana area.
