

# Haiti - Community Transformation Chilliwack Alliance Church October 2004

The original objective of the Chilliwack Alliance Church was to travel to Laraque where they would be assisting in the building of a Church. Due to the circumstances at the time, the region of the country where the team was to travel was struck by a hurricane a few weeks before arrival.

## Projected Objectives:

- To improve Kenscoff Orphanage by:
  - building shelves for storage
  - painting the interior of the orphanage
  - to build a cement house for the generator
  - to give all 30 kids and staff a medical checkup
  - distribute back packs with school and hygiene supplies
  - to love and play with the children
- To partner with a local agency, Mountain Top Ministries, to provide medical assistance and to the local community of Grammothe.

## Completed Objectives:

- At Kenscoff Orphanage:
  - Storage shelves
  - The interior was painted
  - A cement house for the generator
  - Medical checkups
  - Backpacks were distributed
  - Door frames leading into the building were replaced
- At Mountain Top Ministries:
  - Ran a medical clinic for 8 days
  - Painted class rooms
  - Built shelves and doll houses
  - Worked with the local church
  - Worked on future building projects



## Wish List for Gifts of Kenscoff Orphanage:

- The team came up with a list of things that they would like to see accomplished:
  - a sink put in the upstairs bathroom
  - swing set, bookshelves, toy boxes and ping pong table
  - kitchen shelves
  - level out limestone for basketball court
  - sidewalk from the kitchen to the cook house
  - cement pad for laundry area with drains
