Promontory Community Church
Uganda, Mukono
June 1 - 8, 2009

Trip Objectives:

To visit our field partner Noah's Ark Children's Ministry Uganda (NACMU) and determine the long-term role the church will play in caring for the abandoned children of Mukono.

Team:

3 people from the Promontory Community Church, including Pastor Shawn Van Dop travelled to Mukono, Uganda for 7 days. The HFL team leader was Steve Johnson.

Completed Objectives:

The accomplishments of team's trip are as follows:

- > Visited local tourist destination Jinja
- > Pastor Shawn shared the gospel at Noah's Ark church service
- > Team blessed partner with soccer balls and socks for the kids
- > Facilitated the arrival of 3 cows to the newly constructed Dairy Barn
- > Provided water bowls and shut off valves that will allow animals to access clean water all the time.

The team was blessed with the opportunity to travel with our partners Piet and Pita to Kampala to receive a new child. This child was abandoned on the side of the road, left for dead, but is now a part of a large family and has a life full of love. The team also determined that they will work alongside Noah's Ark in constructing a secondary vocational school in the near future, which will include sending teams to facilitate the construction. The team was able to complete much of the work on the Dairy project, leaving it with 2 pregnant cows and one that is already providing milk to the children's home.
