Sept 2 - 11, 2009

### Trip Objectives:

To visit the newly constructed medical clinic at Noah's Ark Children's Ministry Uganda (NACMU) and provide assistance in the start of its operation.



### Team:

3 people from Springbank church, a husband/wife doctor team and their son; alongside HFL Project Manager Steve Johnson and his family (3) travelled to NACMU in Mukono, Uganda

### Completed Objectives:

List the accomplishments of team's trip:

- > Team was able to go on Safari for a day getaway from the busyness of the children's home
- > The Doctors were able to help oversee the staffing of the clinic during its start up
- > An elderly women with a chest infection was visited and treated
- > A school teacher at NACMU was treated for head trauma and concussion
- > Team was able to witness the arrival of 2 new babies to NACMU: Levi & Thomas.
- > Met with local District Director whom will be able to help facilitate work permits for visiting doctors
- > Team visited the homes of 2 of the kids from NACMU's school and were able to visit with their families
- > Played with and loved on many of the 110 children of NACMU

This trip was in a sense a vision trip for the team. The team was able to evaluate the clinic, alongside the medical needs of the community. They plan to have other medical professionals from Springbank Church and surrounding area to come visit NACMU for 2 weeks at a time and provide oversight for the clinic and direction in diagnosis and administration. There may possibly be a need for medical teams to come and serve at NACMU as the need for medical professionals is great in Uganda.
