



Trip Results

Fraser Valley Team
Nikopol, Ukraine
October 30–November 15, 2007

Trip Objectives:

This small team of women were a part of the first Ukraine team in 2004 and had the opportunity to visit those who have been receiving aid over the past four years to see and hear the impact it has had on their lives. In addition, they developed new relationships by making house visits and providing a dinner to those who need assistance. They also visited the Priazovje Orphanage to see the development of the boy's workshop, which was funded by the Tiegen Memorial fund.

Team:

The team consisted of three women from the Fraser Valley; Mary Martz was the HFL team leader.

Completed Objectives:

The team accomplished the following:

- › Provided 1 month supply to 95 people
- › Provided 1 month supply of hygiene supplies to 95 people
- › Distributed 45 pairs of shoes and 182 pairs of socks to orphans
- › Distributed clothing to various families and orphans
- › Purchased medical supplies for Pasha (quadriplegic)
 - Vitamins, contributed to cost of rehab treatment, purchased mattress
- › Provided funds to repair road in Shishkino
- › Purchased coal that will provide 2 people heat for 3 months
- › Replaced 2 windows at Priazovje Orphanage
- › Contributed funds for renovations of Nikopol Church
- › Contributed funds for families home renovations
- › Contributed towards purchase of a home for mother of 3
- › Provided funds to repair local partners vehicle
- › Contributed to deacons fund enabling 9 deacons to travel to remote villages for 4 months
