

Ukraine April 2004

A team of 5 ladies traveled to the eastern region of the Ukraine to care for orphans & widows. They demonstrated & communicated the love of the Father by providing for their basic needs.

The team improved the health & general wellbeing of the neglected widows & children by providing them with food, clothing, & compassionate care.

Completed Objectives:

- They traveled to orphanages handing out small gifts to encourage the 320 orphaned children.
- Heat was provided for 30 widows for the upcoming winter.
- Food supplies were purchased and put together to make 350 food hampers.
- Prescription drugs were purchased for 150 people who have been examined by a local Christian doctor.
- 4 feeding programs were held in 4 locations.
- 50 food hampers were delivered to bedridden widows.
- 65 Bibles, 30 Children's Bibles, & 30 Gospels of John were distributed.
- 20 Orphan girls were given one year's supply of feminine hygiene products.
- Well over 1,700 pounds of clothing, including close to 4,000 adult diapers were shipped & distributed.
- Funds were provided to cover the remaining costs of purchasing a van for the local pastor.
